PUPPY/DOG CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT is made by and between VON JAGENSTADT GERMAN SHEPHERD DOGS, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Seller" or "Breeder") and

_____ (hereinafter referred to as "Buyer" or "Purchaser"),

on this _____ day of _____, 200__, for the sale of one(1) German Shepherd Male/Female for the price and sum of \$_____ further described as:

_____ von Jagenstadt (hereinafter referred to as "said dog") with (Full/Restricted) registration with complete guarantee.

in accordance with the stipulations set forth below.

(1) The above described animal is a purebred dog and is registered with the AKC registering agency.

(2) The health of said dog is excellent to the best of the Breeder's knowledge and belief at the time of sale. The required vaccinations and wormings are current; however, Breeder advises the Purchaser to have a competent licensed veterinarian of his own choice examine said dog within 48 hours of receiving the dog. If the veterinarian finds said dog in poor health, the dog may be returned to the Seller.

(3) Seller guarantees that said dog will obtain an OFA certification of at least an OFA Fair by 26 months of age. X-ray films of the hips showing proper positioning, and meeting OFA standards, must be submitted to OFA for evaluation at the owner's expense for guarantee to be valid. If OFA deems that said dog shows evidence of Hip dysplasia, an evaluation letter from OFA MUST be supplied, and Buyer may be asked to produce a copy of the X-rays to be forwarded to the Seller's veterinarian.

Seller will then give Buyer the option of returning said dog to Seller or keeping the dog and Seller will replace the dog with a similar dog in value and characteristics. If Buyer chooses to keep said dog, Seller will need proof that the dog has been spayed or neutered.

Seller reserves the right to refuse Buyer a replacement pup for any reason and, in that event, Seller will then offer a full refund of the purchase price.

All shipping costs will be the responsibility of the Buyer.

By signing this contract, Purchaser acknowledges it has been informed that young bones and growth plates have not completely matured and do not properly calcify until at least 12 months of age. Purchaser acknowledges Seller will guarantee the hips, providing the Purchaser agrees it will not allow environmental conditions to adversely affect the development of the hip structure. Purchaser will provide a certified nutritionally complete food that will not promote excessive growth or obesity. Purchaser will provide regular moderate exercise. Purchaser is aware that if it allows said dog to engage in activities that would stress the hips before the age of 12 months, the hip guarantee will then become null and void. Activities include, but not exclusively, exercise on hard unyielding surfaces, continuous running, repetitive jumping, training in competitive dog sports, or any activity that may cause injury.

No further health guarantee is made.

(4) Buyer agrees to maintain said dog in good health, provide routine preventative health care including, but not limited to, inoculation, internal and external parasites, and where indicated, heartworm preventative medication.

(5) Buyer agrees Seller will REPOSSESS said dog UPON EVIDENCE OF NEGLIGENCE AND/OR ABUSE at no expense to the Seller.

(6) This contract applies only to _____ von Jagenstadt and is non-transferable to a second party.

(7) Buyer may return said dog within 48 hours from the date of purchase for a full refund of original purchase price if a licensed veterinarian finds the dog to be unfit for sale. Unfit for sale on account of an injury sustained, or illness contracted after you take possession of said dog does not deem it "unfit for sale." Buyer agrees to pay all transportation costs back to Seller. Even though all dogs/puppies are wormed, a veterinary finding of intestinal or external parasites is not grounds for declaring a dog unfit for sale unless the animal is clinically ill because of that condition. Buyer is advised to follow up on the proper immunizations with their vet.

(8) In order to receive an adjustment, under the terms of this sales contract, the Buyer must return signed AKC papers to Seller before any adjustment can be made. Buyer must make said dog available to Seller or designee for appropriate examination and evaluation.

(9) Breeder does not guarantee against any environmental temperament problems, environmental referring to abuse, neglect, teasing, or failing to train the dog properly. Breeder strongly suggests that the Purchaser take said dog to obedience classes to learn proper handling techniques.

(10) Buyer agrees to provide Seller with photographs suitable for advertising and photocopies of all awards and critiques along with the judge(s) name(s) and the Club sponsoring the show. Buyer also agrees that Seller may use the photographs and any particulars of qualifying awards in any future advertising.

(11) There are no further guarantees or warranties implied.

(12) Any legal disputes must be settled in Seller's county.
